Longfield Agility Novice

The Longfield Agility Novice Qualifier is a competition for Large dogs, eligible for grades 3, 4 & 5. There will be approximately ten qualifying heats.

The Longfield Agility Novice Final will be held at the Docs Dogs August show on the 26th August 2017.

The winner of the final will receive £100 in cash and a £150 voucher towards equipment from Longfield Agility Solutions.

This class must be judged under the appropriate Kennel Club Rules in force at the time of the competition for a standard open class.

If the entry for a heat exceeds the KC limit for a class in a day, then the class will be equally and randomly split in accordance with current Kennel Club regulations. All competitors entering the class will be deemed to have agreed to abide by the rules of the Kennel Club and the specific regulations governing this class.

The competition is open to Kennel Club registered dogs eligible to compete at Large Height in grades 3, 4 & 5 and competing at 650mm jump height.

Where the qualifier is held at a show where the full height and LHO results are combined, only the top 5 dogs running at 650mm jump height will be awarded the invitations to compete in the final.

Handlers may enter more than one dog in the competition and may qualify more than one dog for the final.

The first five full height dogs (650mm jump height) from the heat will be invited to compete in the final. The next five full height dogs will be held as reserves. If the class is split the top three full height dogs from each part will be invited to compete in the final. The next top three full height in each part to be held as reserves.

Once a dog has qualified for the final it may enter further heats. Handlers who have already qualified their dog for the final should report this fact to the appropriate Show Secretary before running in the class. If the already qualified dog then qualifies again, that place will be awarded to the highest placed unqualified dog running at full height.

In the event of a dog being unable to compete in the final due to unavailability, illness or injury, the reserves from that heat will be invited in numerical order.

In the event of a handler being unable to compete in a final due to illness or injury, a substitute handler for the qualifying dog will be allowed to run the dog.

Trophies will be awarded to third place and rosettes to 15th place in these qualifiers.

ELIGIBILITY AND SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prize or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club Open licensed Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: "A Ramp", Dog Walk and See-Saw.

With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

Class Structure. A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for one or more consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

Progression. Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins in standard classes at that grade, at either Full height or the Lower Height Option, except that progression from Grade 5 will require 3 wins at grade 5, one of which must be an agility class. Progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

Lower Height Option Societies may offer the Lower Height Option to all dogs in that height category and may be offered at all grades. It is to be run as part of any Standard class as defined in the regulations and must be clearly identified in the schedule. Each relevant class will have two heights with a change part way through to higher/lower the jump heights and competitors must run at their entered height. The order in which the heights will run must be detailed on the ring cards/ring plan. There will be only one course walking at the start of the class. In a class where the Lower Height Option is available show organisers may offer one set of awards by combining the results of each height or may offer separate awards for each height category.

When the Lower Height Option is scheduled a dog may only be entered at either the Full Height or the Lower Height and it cannot compete at a different height in any other class at that competition, including special classes. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule.

Points Progression. At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers), except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however, once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade. **Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.**

STANDARD CLASSES

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1 (Elementary)

For owners, handlers and dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

Grade 2 (Starters)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.*

Grade 3 (Graduate)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 (Novice)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 (Intermediate)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 (Senior)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 3 first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an Agility (not jumping) Class, and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5, or 7.

Grade 7 (Advanced)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

Dogs may only enter one type of Class i.e. small-medium-large except for Any Size Jumping, Veteran and Non Veteran.

Dogs may only work in the class heights they are eligible for i.e ~ small, medium, large

SPECIAL CLASSES

Veteran and Non Veteran ~ Open to Small, Medium and Large dogs not entered in any other class over the weekend. (Any Size Jumping excepted) ~ 9 years or over if a Border Collie, WSD or Collie cross and 7 years or over for all other dogs on the closing date of the show. (12th May 2017.) See rule 19 for jump heights.

There will not be any weaves, long jump or tyre in this class

VETERAN CLASSES. COLLIE AND A.B.C. WILL RUN TOGETHER AS ONE CLASS. SMALL, MEDIUM AND LARGE.

Any Size ~ Open to all dogs not entered in any other class over the weekend (veterans or non veteran special class excepted).

See rule 19 for jump heights. There will not be any weaves long jump or tyre in this class

Veteran Handler Jumping ~ Open to Handlers aged 60 and over on the day of the show

Juniors ~ **To include Small Medium and Large dogs.**

SPECIAL NOVICE HANDLER JUNIOR. (CLASSES 25 AND 56) OPEN TO JUNIOR HANDLERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW WHO HAVE NOT WON ANY STANDARD CLASS OR 2 JUNIOR CLASSES AT ANY K.C.SHOW

SPECIAL EXPERIENCED HANDLER JUNIOR. (CLASSES 26 AND 57) OPEN TO JUNIOR HANDLERS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR CLASS 25 OR 56

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes, but must be specified in the schedule. Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/Authority to Compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Entry Fee £3.10 Per Dog Per Class. Entry Fee For Helping Members £1.60 (See Rule 42).
Camping Wednesday to Saturday nights inclusive £25.00 per unit. Friday and Saturday nights only inclusive £20.00 per unit.
4. Prizes ~ No Cash Prizes are on offer at this show.
5. There are no facilities for entering this show via the internet.
6. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
8. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
9. Organisers of Open Agility shows may set a capping level on the entries to be accepted in any standard or special class, and may decline entries received after the capping level has been reached. State if specific classes are to be capped and the capping limit. The capping level must be set at a minimum of 250 entries received. There is no maximum level at which a cap may be set.
10. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
11. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
12. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competitions is forbidden.
13. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
14. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
15. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
16. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges
17. Sponsors - Staffordshire Organic Cheese, Tuffstuff, Mr. T's Roasties, Kennel Farm, Longfield Agility Solutions see page 2
18. Kennel Club standard marking regulations apply for all standard classes.
19. Jump height for Veterans, Non Veterans and Any size special class: handlers may choose whichever height suits their dogs (max 450mm)
20. The Height limit for dogs.
 - a. Large Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
 - b. Medium Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
 - c. Small Dog classes - For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
21. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.

22. Removal of dogs from Competition ~ Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the Show if it is:-
- A bitch which is in season.
 - Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - Of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
- The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show incident book and submitted to the Kennel Club.
23. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
24. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition (ie 20th June 2017) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show (by 1/07/17). The dog should then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
25. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
26. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event the society will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within one month of the show date.
27. Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand or while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to a dog whilst in the ring.
28. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
29. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
30. Free Passes ~ Not Applicable.
31. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.
32. It is the competitors responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club.
33. Animals in Event ~ No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.
However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
34. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
35. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring must be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
36. Welfare of Dogs An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
37. Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn.
Failure to do so may result in elimination..
38. Dogs may enter no more than 4 classes per day including **Juniors and/or Veteran Handler**. Dogs that enter classes 27,28,29,30,31,58,59,60,61 & 62 may not enter any other class at this weekend show.
39. Dogs will not be accepted in a class after the class closed call has been given.
40. All dogs are entered at their owners' risk, whilst every care will be taken, the Wirral Alsatian Training Society will not accept responsibility for the loss, damage or injury to any persons, dogs or property.
41. No refunds will be given in the event of incorrect monies being submitted, it is the competitors responsibility to check the paperwork before submission, all entry forms must contain the signature of the owner before a dog is eligible to take part in the show.
42. Competitors must follow the instructions of the stewards with respect to parking, camping and conduct within the show boundaries, there should be a clear roadway between aisles of campers for safety reasons, no fencing across from one aisle to another will be allowed. Campers are responsible for their own fire precautions within camping accommodation. A fire bucket with either water or sand must be positioned at the front of each camping unit.
43. For members to receive the reduced entry fees, they must complete and return a members helping form, with their entry. Forms will be available at agility training or by email..
43. Veteran classes are open to small, medium and large dogs, 9 years or over if a Border Collie, WSD or their crosses and 7 years or over for all other dogs on the closing date of the show. (12th May 2017). For Jump heights please see rule no. 19. .
44. The parking of vehicles and camping is at the risk of the owners and Wirral ATS will not be held responsible for any damages caused. The show ground is in close proximity to a golf course and cricket pitch and stray balls may occur.
45. Smoking will not be permitted in any of the tents, awnings or marquees which are in use for the general public/competitors at the show.
46. No refunds after the closing date except in exceptional circumstances.
